ORVILLE GBC – PASTOR JOSH STEINER

Live-Stream Class on Salvation and the Christian Life (3 credit hours)

The class will be held Saturday mornings from 8:30 -10:30am (EST) from February 22, 2020 to May 16, 2020 at the Orrville Grace Brethren Church building, and can be watched live over the internet. This course will be taught by Pastor Ike. This is the fourth of 6 theology courses covering the major theological topics of the Bible in a systematic fashion. This course focuses on the biblical spectrum of terminology related to salvation such as election, predestination, calling, belief, faith, repentance, justification, sanctification, and how all these fit together in the plan of God for our spiritual growth and service to the Lord. A student is not required to have had Hebrew or Greek for this course, so it is available to anyone who would like to participate; either for credit or audit (\$50 to audit; \$150 to take for credit). Those taking it for credit will have collateral reading assigned and also will take a mid-term and final exam for the course grade. If you are interested in taking this course, please register with Pastor Joshua Steiner by February 10, 2020, in order to obtain the required course materials on time for the first class. REVITALIZE VERMONT with PASTOR BRYAN MALEY, IRASBURG GBC, and LAMOILLE VALLEY GBC

Luke 1:37 "For with God nothing shall be impossible." Seemingly impossible things are taking place in OUR CGBCI CHURCHES THROUGHOUT THE LAND!! PRAISE THE LORD!! In Vermont we are hearing things like JOY, GROWTH, SERVING, SALVATIONS, and BAPTISMS!!

The Maleys (Pastor Bryan, Tori, Camden, Aubrey, Alex and Roxi) are now at their one year benchmark! They are trusting the Lord of All to lead them, guide them, and use them for His glory and purpose. Pastor Scott Libby expresses that Pastor Bryan is a BIG encouragement to him personally and to the church.

THINGS ARE HAPPENING! Irasburg reported that their CANDY CARNIVAL in October was well attended, seeing about 60 people, some of whom were NEW faces. They passed out treats and tracts and had good interaction; but PRAY—so far no one has attended IGBC as a result. Lamoille Valley GBC PASSED OUT 500 CANDY BAGS with tracts and established several personal contacts. Because Halloween Night there was rainy, cold, miserable, and raw, many people were looking for a place to dry out, and warm up a little. This resulted in them hanging around the church building, going through the cardboard maze, and staying longer than usual. All things work together!

Pastor Scott was teaching through the Book of John in a small group, and the Lord brought a young lady (Anissa) in her 20s who is now a NEW BELIEVER and was BAPTIZED on November 24th! "I will build MY church." Please that she would "grow in the grace and knowledge of the Lord Jesus Christ."

THE HOME MISSIONS PANEL UPDATE DECEMBER 17, 2019 with PASTOR PHILIP MOELLER

EMERGENCY NEED: The Irasburg Church and the Lamoille Valley Church are asking for your help!

When the Maleys moved to their farm house in Vermont they sought The Lord for His choice. And while they love their new house it has come with some health threatening issues ... BLACK MOLD. As a matter of fact they discovered mold in the master bedroom immediately upon their arrival last year. Even before the boxes were unpacked they found themselves in the middle of a construction job. Once again a dangerous mold issue has been revealed, this time in the main bathroom. So now they are under construction again. They are working to remedy this situation because it is affecting their health! The first job last year cost the Maleys \$8,000 out of pocket. This bathroom repair will cost about \$15,000 out of pocket.

There is MORE. The Home Missions Panel has learned that Bryan's Home Mission's Budget is not enough. The cost of living in Vermont is approximately \$10,000 more than expected. As a result the written plan is being re-worked by Pastor Bryan, Pastor Scott Libby, Pastor Ethan Kallberg, and the elders and the churches in Vermont to then be approved by the HMP early in the new year.

With the Maleys' support level at 74%, the H. M. P. and our Vermont Churches are asking you to please consider helping with the additional mold expenses of \$23,000. It has drained their savings account and placed their family in a position where he is prayerfully considering taking a second job outside the church. Just a reminder - Prayerfully consider supporting the Revitalize Vermont Work!
