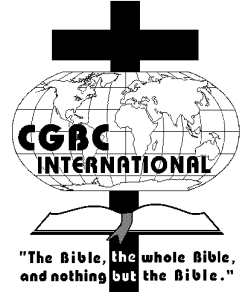

Girls, 1 Timothy 2:9-10 reads, *“Likewise, I want women to adorn themselves with proper clothing, modestly and discreetly, not with braided hair and gold or pearls or costly garments; but rather by means of good works, as befits women making a claim to godliness.”* The word “adorn” refers not only to how you clothe yourself, but also to your attitude about what you wear. That is emphasized in the phrase, “not with braided hair and gold or pearls or costly garments.” Wearing braided hair is not a sin unless it is done by weaving in gold, pearls, etc. to draw attention to yourself. Attitude is the key issue. Is your attitude one whereby you want to honor the Lord Jesus and draw attention to Him and not yourself? In addition, the word “modest” carries the idea of being sensitive to causing someone else to sin.

If you dress in such a way that guys stare at you, then you could be causing them to sin because boys/men are stimulated sexually through what they see. The word “discreet” means to dress with self-control. In other words, you are controlling the desire to draw attention to yourself. You will dress in such a way to not cause the focus of others to fall on you. To make this more specific for those to whom this may be new, the next page has specific guidelines that all team members are to follow.

Clothing Guidelines:

: GIRLS :

Shirts

- Neckline comes to 3 fingers from the notch at the base of the neck.
- Short sleeved or longer
- Covers the stomach & back when bending over
- Loose fitting and not skin tight

Skirts/Dresses/Shorts/Capris/Pants

- Knee length or longer (modest back slits only)
- Loose fitting and not skin tight

Swimwear

- One piece swimsuit
- Dark t-shirt & shorts to wear over the top while swimming

Girls Program Attire:

- Tops/Skirts/dresses that adhere to the above dress requirements.

:GUYS :

Shirts

- Polo/collared shirts are preferred (T-shirts with God honoring messages and images are acceptable)
- Loose fitting and not skin tight
- Short sleeved or longer

Shorts/Pants

- Knee length or longer
- Loose fitting and not skin tight

Swimwear

- Loose fitting swim "trunks"
- Dark t-shirt to wear while swimming

Guys Program Attire:

- Long pants
- Collared shirts
- Dress Footwear (with dark socks)

These guidelines apply to all parts of the trip (work day, sleepwear, travel, recreation, free time, etc.)
Exceptions to the above guidelines must be approved by team leadership.
