

Meeting with God

Leviticus 8-9

Prepare your heart and mind for worship on Sunday, April 14, 2024, each day this week, with the following passages and questions. (RTYB'24= Read Through Your Bible in 2024)

Monday, April 8 **Leviticus 8:1-13**

- Who is initiating all of these actions? Why?
- What does it mean to consecrate? Are you consecrated?
- RTYB'24 – Judges 19-21; and pray for Bonnie Young today.

Tuesday, April 9 **Leviticus 8:14-21**

- What was the purpose of the sin and burnt offering?
- Do all High Priests need to offer these? (See Heb. 7:26-28.)
- RTYB'24 – Ruth 1-4; and pray for the Tim Zook family today.

Wednesday, April 10 **Leviticus 8:22-36**

- How was Aaron consecrated? Why was that important?
- Read 2 Corinthians 6:14—7:1. How do we cleanse today?
- RTYB'24 – 1 Samuel 1-3; and pray for the Olinga family* in Africa today.

Thursday, April 11 **Leviticus 9:1-7**

- Why is another sin and burnt offering required?
- Meditate on 'the LORD will appear to you' (v. 6).
- RTYB'24 – 1 Samuel 4-6; and pray for the Zambo family* in Africa today.

Friday, April 12 **Leviticus 9:8-21**

- How are these offerings different from the ones in chapter 8?
- Why were these offerings necessary to meet the LORD?
- RTYB'24 – 1 Samuel 7-9; and pray for the Yoda family* in Africa today.

Saturday, April 13 **Leviticus 9:22-24**

- What is the glory of the LORD? How was verse 6 fulfilled?
- Read John 1:14-18. How did Jesus explain the Father?
- RTYB'24 – 1 Sam. 10-13; and pray for the Amaswache family* today.

Sunday, April 14 **Exodus 29:42-46**

- How do Leviticus 8 & 9 fulfill these verses?
- Does God dwell with you today? How do you know?
- RTYB'24 – Psalm 45-47; and pray for N.E.T. '24 today.
