PRESIDENT'S CORNER – PASTOR DAVE BLEVINS

In the opening two verses of 1 Corinthians 15 we read, "Moreover, brethren, I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received and in which you stand, by which also you are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you unless you believed in vain." What does Paul mean when he says, "unless you believed in vain"? He answers that question in 1 Corinthians 15:10 when he says, "But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me was not in vain; but I labored more abundantly than they all, yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me."

In my article last month we looked at Paul's testimony of his conversion. Paul wanted to make sure that his salvation wasn't in "vain" which literally means "empty." When people looked at his life he wanted them to see a change! As Grace Brethren, we often say that we are a "Bible believing church" which is true, but the real question is: Do you believe it enough to put what we believe into practice? We must make sure that we are "doers of the word" rather than just "hearers." James 1:22 makes clear those who do so are "self deceived." We want our lives to reflect Christ, so that others will desire to come to know Him as their Savior as well. Years ago, before I was a Pastor, I was on my lunch break at work one day when we were extremely busy trying to meet a deadline, and I had forgotten to pray for my lunch. My usual routine was to just close my eyes and silently thank the Lord for my food. This only involved a few seconds, and without saying anything all of my coworkers knew what I was doing. No big deal, right? On that particular day when my routine was "altered" due to the time constraint, several people in the break room quickly said, "Aren't you going to pray for your food?" Something so simple and yet people noticed. A good reminder that people do indeed watch us to see if our actions match our words.

Our 2023 Conference theme is "Transformed!" We live in a world that is rapidly changing and it is more important than ever for us as Christians to live out our faith. I believe the theme that the Lord laid on my heart this year couldn't come at a better time, and I am excited to see what the Lord has in store for us.


