

Why Preserve Unity?

Ephesians 4:4-5

Prepare your heart and mind for worship on Sunday, June 11, 2023, each day this week, with the following passages and questions. (RTYB'23= Read Through Your Bible in 2023)

Monday, June 5 **Ephesians 4:1-6**

- How do verses 4-6 connect with verses 1-3?
- What is significant about the word 'one' in this context?
- RTYB'23 – Amos 4-6; and pray for the Joshua Steiner family today.

Tuesday, June 6 **Deuteronomy 6:1-6**

- In how many persons does the One true God exist?
- How does this truth influence our unity as believers?
- RTYB'23 – Amos 7-9; and pray for the Mark Steiner family today.

Wednesday, June 7 **Matthew 3:13-17**

- Identify the role of each member of the trinity in this account.
- Is there ever a conflict between the persons of God?
- RTYB'23 – 2 Kings 15-17; and pray for the Tommy Steiner family today.

Thursday, June 8 **1 Corinthians 12:14-26**

- Review Ephesians 4:4 and note the connection.
- Why should believers preserve unity according to these verses?
- RTYB'23 – 2 Kings 18-21; and pray for Shirley Stewart today.

Friday, June 9 **Philippians 1:23-30**

- How can believers 'strive together' for the faith of the gospel?
- What common 'end-goal' do we share as believers?
- RTYB'23 – 2 Kings 22-25; and pray for the Kyle Tobias family today.

Saturday, June 10 **Jude 1-4**

- Define 'the faith' in verse 3. Connect it to Ephesians 4:5.
- How important is correct doctrine? (Read the rest of Jude.)
- RTYB'23 – 1 Chron. 1-3; and pray for the Ray Troyer family today.

Sunday, June 11 **Ephesians 2:14-22**

- How do these verses connect with Ephesians 4:3-5?
- What role do you play in preserving unity in our church?
- RTYB'23 – Psalm 72-74; and pray for Lola Wertz today.
