Ephesians 3:20-21

Prepare your heart and mind for worship on Sunday, May 28, 2023, each day this week, with the following passages and questions. (RTYB'23= Read Through Your Bible in 2023)

Monday, May 22 **Ephesians 3:20-21**

- What does it mean to “bless” God? Read Psalm 103.
- How did King David bless God in this Psalm?
- RTYB'23 – Eccl. 5-8; and pray for Joel & Patience Kuhns today.

Tuesday, May 23 **Matthew 5:1-16**

- Is glorifying God and blessing God the same thing?
- What does it mean to glorify God? How do you glorify Him?
- RTYB'23 – Eccl. 9-12; and pray for Kenny & Jenny Kuhns today.

Wednesday, May 24 **Psalms 100**

- Notice verse 4. What 2 ideas are parallel with each other?
- See if you can find the significance of “bless” in this verse.
- RTYB'23 – 1 Kings 12-14 and pray for Diane Martin today.

Thursday, May 25 **Psalms 145**

- Notice verses 1-2 and 21. What is being conveyed?
- Give 3 reasons why you and I should praise God daily.
- RTYB'23 – 1 Kings 15-17 and pray for Pastor Del & Grace Miller today.

Friday, May 26 **John 21**

- Focus on verse 19. How did Peter's death glorify God?
- Will you glorify God in your death? How?
- RTYB'23 – 1 Kings 18-20; and pray for Don & Debbie Miller today.

Saturday, May 27 **1 Peter 4**

- Notice verse 16. How can we glorify God in suffering?
- Are you ashamed or rejoicing when you suffer as a Christian?
- RTYB'23 – 1 Kings 21-22 and pray for Pastor Josh & Autumn Miller today.

Sunday, May 28 **Deuteronomy 8:1-10**

- Notice verse 10. What is Israel to bless the Lord for?
- How are you doing in this regard? Do you bless the Lord?
- RTYB'23 – Psalm 66-68 and pray for Donna Moeller today.
