Monday, May 29 **Ephesians 4:1-3**

- To what does 'therefore' in verse 1 refer?
- To what calling have we been called? See Eph. 1:4ff.
- RTYB'23 – 2 Kings 2-4; and pray for Dan & Billie Jo Najimian today.

Tuesday, May 30 **Ephesians 4:2-3**

- Read also Colossians 3:12-17.
- Note some of the parallels between these two passages.
- RTYB'23 – 2 Kings 5-7; and pray for Vickie Page today.

Wednesday, May 31 **Philippians 2:3-8**

- How did Christ demonstrate humility?
- In what way is God calling you to demonstrate humility?
- RTYB'23 – 2 Kings 8-10; and pray for the Carl Peppard family today.

Thursday, June 1 **Ephesians 4:3**

- Read also John 17:20-26.
- What is the basis for our unity as brothers and sisters?
- RTYB'23 – 2 Kings 11:1-14:25; and pray for Clennon Presson today.

Friday, June 2 **2 Peter 1:5-11**

- Are these qualities yours and increasing (v. 8)?
- How do these verses connect with Ephesians 4:1-3?
- RTYB'23 – Jonah; and pray for the Mike Shoup family today.

Saturday, June 3 **James 3:13-18**

- Do you walk in wisdom and make peace?
- What should our motivation be to do so? (See Ephesians 4:1.)
- RTYB'23 – 2 Kings 14:26-29 & Amos 1-3; and pray for the Smail family.

Sunday, June 4 **Ephesians 4:1-3**

- Memorize one, two, or all three of these verses.
- How can you be a doer (James 1:25) of these verses this week?
- RTYB'23 – Psalm 69-71; and pray for the Duane Steiner family today.
