PRESIDENT'S CORNER – PASTOR DAVE BLEVINS

When you think of people from the Bible whose lives were truly transformed, doubtful that Ruth comes to mind for many. The small, four-chapter book that bears her name in the Old Testament is a remarkable story of redemption, love and the transforming power of God. In the opening chapter, after losing her husband and two sons, Naomi makes the decision to return to Bethlehem, because the famine that had led to the family's decision to go to Moab in the first place was now over. It had been a costly ten years. Although both of her Moabite daughters-in-law initially plan to return to Bethlehem with her, Naomi convinces Orpah that she would be better off staying in Moab. Ruth, on the other hand, we are told in verse 14, "clung to her" mother-in-law. Ruth's decision to go with Naomi demonstrates an unusual devotion and commitment. In Chapter 1 verses 16 and 17 we read, "But Ruth said: "Entreat me not to leave you, or to turn back from following after you; for wherever you go, I will go; and wherever you lodge, I will lodge; your people shall be my people, and your God, my God. Where you die, I will die, and there will I be buried. The Lord do so to me, and more also, if anything but death parts you and me." Not only does Ruth express devotion to Naomi, but more importantly to Naomi's God. She's going to go, live, die and even be buried wherever Naomi is. Just think about it, once Naomi dies you would think Ruth would desire to return to her people, but her commitment is a total transformation. In Ruth chapter 4 we read of God rewarding her faithfulness. Ruth's son, Obed, would become the grandfather of king David. It is also significant that both Boaz and Ruth are mentioned in the Messianic genealogy in Matthew 1:5. It is hard to summarize such a wonderful book in a brief article, but indeed Ruth is a tremendous example of a life that was transformed!

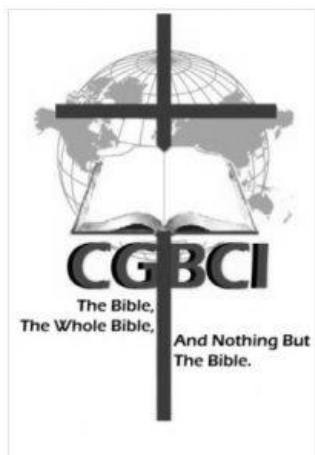
