The Apostle Paul, whose conversion in Acts Chapter 9 will be the subject of our Bible Hour Saturday morning on July 1st, with a message from Pastor Ethan Kallberg, was a life that was undeniably transformed. Three times in Scripture, Paul encouraged believers to follow his example. In 1 Corinthians 4:16, Paul wrote, "Therefore I urge you, imitate me." Also in 1 Corinthians 11:1, he said, "Imitate me," just as I also imitate Christ." To the church in Philippi he wrote in Philippians 3:17, "Brethren, join in following my example, and note those who so walk, as you have us for a pattern." Paul understood that when you take a stand for Christ, people will be watching your life. He was able to encourage others to follow his example, because he closely followed Jesus. Whether we like it or not, people are watching! The question each of us needs to ask is, "What do they see?" I remember years ago having a conversation with someone at church (before I was a pastor) and a certain man's name came up in the conversation. The man's name was unusual enough that it was doubtful there was more than one person with that name in that area. When I mentioned the man's name in the conversation (we were talking sports) the guy I was talking to said, "That's the name of my boss at work." As we continued the conversation my friend said, "There is no way it was the same guy, because his boss had a pretty foul mouth and was mean and hateful towards his employees." The guy that I knew was a deacon at the church I grew up in. I'm sure you guessed, it turned out to be the same guy. His life at work did not match his life at church. Over the years as a pastor, I've had occasions where someone will ask, "Does so and so go to your church?" and when I answer, "Yes, he does" the response is, "He doesn't have a very good testimony," or "He isn't who you think he is!" Every time this happens, I always ask myself, "Am I being a good testimony?" As believers, we are all sinners saved by grace, but need to be constantly aware of this one simple fact: "We are the only Jesus some people will ever see."

Our 2023 Conference theme is "Transformed!" I am looking forward to our Bible Hours. We will be looking at the lives of people who were truly transformed. By looking at the lives of others, like Paul, we can examine our own lives and be challenged and encouraged to do better for the Lord.


