PRESIDENT'S CORNER – PASTOR DAVE BLEVINS

Without question, one of the most well-known events in history is the crucifixion of Jesus Christ. It is interesting to see the different effects that this single event has on people. To many people, it is all "foolishness." 1 Corinthians 1:18 says, "For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God." Sadly, for many, they are "perishing" because the cross to them is "foolish". For others, the cross has "power", which is experienced by "faith", and ONLY faith!

As we look to our Conference Theme, "Transformed," a fascinating character of genuine transformation emerges from the Easter story. In Luke 23:39-43 we read, "Then one of the criminals who were hanged blasphemed Him, saying, 'If You are the Christ, save Yourself and us.' But the other, answering, rebuked him, saying, 'Do you not even fear God, seeing you are under the same condemnation? And we indeed justly, for we receive the due reward of our deeds; but this Man has done a nothing wrong.' Then he said to Jesus, "Lord, remember me when You come into Your kingdom.' And Jesus said to him, 'Assuredly, I say to you, today you will be with Me in Paradise.'" Although you may not think of the thief on the cross as being "transformed", with one simple statement of faith his eternal destination changed. Because his decision is part of Scripture, lives are still being impacted by it. His story is living proof of what Paul writes in Romans 10:9, "that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved." Not only did he confess Jesus as Lord, but he acknowledged that Jesus would rise again as a "King with a kingdom." Based on Romans 10:9, those who have those two ingredients will be saved. In turn, Jesus' response to him, "today you will be with Me in Paradise," was the only thing He could have said. I look forward to meeting him some day.
