PRESIDENT'S CORNER – PASTOR PETER PEER

I have to admit, this is my favorite time of year. The daffodils are blooming, the grass has that beautiful deep green hue of spring, and the birds are filling the air with their joyful songs. Most of all I love this time of year because of the commemoration of our Lord's death, burial, and resurrection. In case you didn't know, Palm Sunday is my favorite Sunday of the year. It is the day when the son of David, the lawful king of Israel, the King of kings, the Lord of lords, and the Lamb of God rode on a donkey into Jerusalem the place of his rightful throne. There he cast out the merchants and the money changers who defiled his temple. For the next several days until Passover he subjected Himself to the interrogations of the religious elite who sought to catch Him at His words. In every case He answered with such wisdom that His enemies marveled. Thereby He proved that He was the spotless Lamb of God worthy to bear the sins of the world. So, on the day that the Passover lambs were being slaughtered He gave "His life a ransom for many" Mark 10:45.

Those truths fill me with an unimaginable thrill and that's why I love this time of year. That thrill reminds me of my duty to my Savior that in every way must live for him. The apostle Paul put it this way, Philippians 1:20-21 ". . . my earnest expectation and hope that in nothing I shall be ashamed, but with all boldness, as always, so now also Christ will be magnified in my body, whether by life or by death. For to me, to live is Christ, and to die is gain." Oswald Chambers commenting on this verse says: "It's as if Paul were saying, 'My determined purpose is to be my utmost for his highest – my best for his glory.' To reach that level of determination is a matter of the will, not of debate or of reasoning. It is absolute and irrevocable surrender of the will at that point."
