PRESIDENT'S CORNER – PASTOR PETER PEER

The new year 2025 is here! I'm sure you all know the New Year blessing: "May all your troubles only last as long as your New Year's resolutions." I do not make New Year's resolutions. My conviction is that every Christian should be resolute in his commitment to the Christian walk every day, not just at the start of a new year. The Christian walk should include, at a minimum, communion with our Lord, spending time in the Word, in prayer every day and living a life of witness before a lost world.

I also believe that every one of our yearly conferences should leave us with a challenge to grow and flourish in our faith. So, at our 2024 conference I laid out a challenge to all pastors, all churches, all church members to make this year:

- A year of consecration
- A year of seeking God's face
- A year of renewed Spiritual discipline
- A year committed to the practice of the faith we profess

As part of that commitment I asked that we pray especially for these needs:

- for 10 new pastors in the next two years
- for the salvation of at least one friend, neighbor, or family member
- for 20 young people for this year's Net ministry

In reviewing what has been done in some of our past years, I feel a bit ashamed that I did not trust God for more. At the national conference of the Fellowship of Brethren Churches in 1948 the challenge went out to win 5,000 souls to Christ in 1949. Two slogans were repeated throughout the year: "5,000 Souls in Brethren Churches in 1949" and "United for Soul-Winning." Of course they had 110 churches but even so 5,000 conversions in one year was a great leap of faith. Of those 110 churches, fourteen were without pastors causing Miles Taber to remark that "In these days that try men's souls, that means that in every one of those fourteen communities God's people are as sheep having no shepherd."

The need for new, committed, capable, loving, and well-trained pastors is a perennial urgency. Brethren, pray the Lord of the harvest that He would send forth laborers into the harvest.
